NO QUIT IN QUINN

QUINN DAVIS won't give up even when it looks BLEAK

Hickory, Rockingham and Nashville were hard-fought disappointments for CGM and Quinn Davis. Unforeseeable technical issues tested the team week after week, but CGM kept showing up, kept working, and kept believing a turnaround would come.

With just two weeks to completely rebuild the car after a steering column failure caused a crash in Nashville, Toledo finally offered a glimpse of a turnaround.

During practice, a freshly rebuilt transmission would not stay in gear. The crew immediately went to work installing the backup, hoping to make qualifying. For a while, it looked unlikely, but the team got it done with just *two minutes* to spare.

With almost no practice and fighting a fever all day, Quinn qualified the CGM Orlando Health Ford in 14th. Because the team missed its allotted qualifying time, she had to start from the very back of the field.

Still, Quinn stayed focused and went to work.

The team made a strategic call not to pit at the scheduled 125-lap break, allowing Quinn to ride the wave and gain a lap back. From there, she battled to a hard-fought P12 finish.

Toledo was more than a race result. It was proof of the grit, determination, and heart behind this team.

CGM does not give up. Quinn does not give up. Together, they are facing every challenge until they find what they are looking for: a championship.

Talladega is one of the toughest races on the ARCA schedule, making the field is a battle of its own.

At superspeedways like Talladega, qualifying is not based only on speed. Owner points play a major role in determining who makes the race. To give ourselves the best shot at qualifying, CGM partnered with another team and utilized the #34 owner points position for the weekend. That strategy helped put the #34 Orlando Health Ford in the field, where Logan Misuraca fought hard all day. The team ran inside the Top 15 for much of the race before a late tire issue changed the outcome, ultimately bringing home a P17 finish while avoiding several major wrecks. For a small grassroots team like CGM, weekends like Talladega are about perseverance, learning, and continuing to grow.

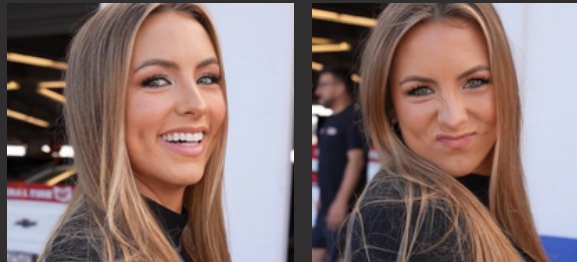

DISAPPOINTMENT IN DAYTONA



Daytona is the biggest stage in NASCAR racing. Superspeedway racing brings a challenge unlike almost anywhere else. Success lives in the draft. A fast car matters, but at Daytona, speed is built in a pack. If the draft breaks apart, even the best-prepared team can find itself seconds off the pace with little chance to recover. During our qualifying session, the pack split and the draft fell apart. It was a tough break after so much preparation, hard work, and belief from our team and driver Logan Misuraca. Our qualifying time landed us at P36 out of a 40 car field. We were confident we would make the field on a provisional, but

post-qualifying tech changed the lineup, provisionals shifted, and we missed the race by one spot, just .032 seconds short. That kind of moment hurts. There is no way around it. But racing has a way of revealing character, and Logan handled the disappointment with professionalism, determination, and grit. Our team is proud of the way she represented CGM in a difficult moment. CGM put in the work. We prepared the right way. We showed up ready. Determined, we took the lessons, regrouped, and kept moving forward.



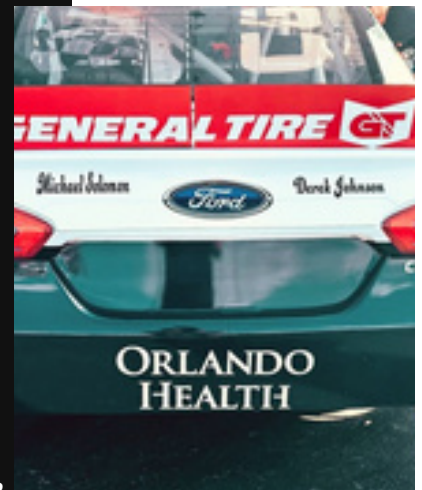
